Sir/ Madam

With reference to your application and subsequent correspondence with the School/inspection in this regard, recognition is granted to Guru Gobind Singh Public School, Maluka, District Bathinda. for class first to eighth. This sanction is subject to the following conditions: -

- The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation to recognize / affiliate beyond class eighth.
- The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure -I) and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2010 (Annexure-II).
- 3) The School shall admit first (or earlier class of school which is applicable) to the extent of 25 % of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
- 4) For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as per sub section (2) of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursement, school shall provide separate bank account.
- 5) The Society/ School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his/ her parents on guardians to any screening procedure.
- 6) The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age proof and comply with the provisions of Section 15 of the Act.
- 7) The School shall ensure that:
 - a) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in school.
 - No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down Rule 25.

- f) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualification as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualification shall acquire such minimum qualification with in a period of 5 years. Statement regarding teaching and non-teaching staff may be enclosed with.
- g) The teachers perform their duties specified under section 24(1) of the Act and
- h) The teachers shall not engage themselves for private teaching activities.
- 8 The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority.
